## A Potential Win for Injury Victims

**A new Florida bill could increase how much injury victims can recover in claims involving government entities and state employees.**

A new Florida bill—HB 145—could increase how much people can recover when injured due to government negligence.

### What's changing?

- Current limits:
  - \$200,000 per person
  - \$300,000 per incident
- Proposed limits:
  - \$350,000 per person
  - \$500,000 per incident

### Why this matters

- **More fair compensation** for serious injuries
- **Less red tape** to recover what you're owed
- **Greater accountability** for government entities

### What to Know

The bill still needs the Governor's signature. If approved, it takes effect **October 1, 2026**.

If you've been injured in an incident involving a government entity, this change could directly impact your case.
